Vance made a motion to approve the WCCD September 20, 2021, board meeting agenda. Susan seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The WCCD Board reviewed the draft for the August 16, 2021, board meeting minutes. Vance made a motion to approve the minutes. Susan seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Amanda provided the WCCD Board with Halli Caines September Monthly report. Discussion was had on the progress with the Nowood Stock Water grant status; possibility of doing Adopt-a-Highway; Halli is completing GIS Training.

Area III Meeting, Susan D. Pennington: Susan provided the Board with an update on the Area III Meeting. NACD Annual Meeting, Dan Rice: Dan provided the Board with an update on the NACD Annual Meeting in Jackson, Wyoming.

OLD BUSINESS

Office Restrictions: Amanda advised the WCCD Board of the new Covid restrictions/policies for the office. Amanda is now teleworking on Mondays and Halli is teleworking Tuesday through Friday. Office is now at 25% employee occupancy and no visitors.

WOTUS: Amanda provided a copy of the WOTUS comments she submitted and a copy of WACD comments.

FY2022 CWA 319 Implementation Grant: Amanda provided the Board with a copy of the application submitted for consideration. Amanda failed to submit to the Board prior to deadline for review and was advised to have Board review all further applications prior to submittal. This would help to make sure that the District is being represented appropriately in the applications.

<u>Bighorn Slick Creek Lower Nowater 319 Implementation Grant, Final Report:</u> Amanda provided the Board with the Final Report for the 319 Grant that was submitted to DEQ.

<u>County Land Project:</u> Amanda approached the Board to clarify what type of match we are anticipating doing for the County Land project. At this time, In Kind Match for time spent coordinating meetings and gathering information.

NEW BUSINESS

WCCD Long Range Land Use Plan 2021: Amanda provided a copy of the Land Use Plan to the Board to review the goals and policies to make sure they are still relevant. Potential Septic Project: Amanda provided the Board with an application for Septic project from Hiedi and Javier

Hernandez. The Board reviewed the application and currently does not see any public benefit to this project. It was

suggested that Amanda reach out and see if they have any further information for consideration and complete a site visit. WACD Convention, Call for RSVP: Amanda provided the Board with information about the WACD Annual Convention being held in Cody November 29-Dec 1, 2021. Amanda advised the Board to reach out if they plan to attend so accommodations can be made.

<u>2021 Hugh Hammond Bennett Award for Conservation Excellence, Call for Nominations:</u> Amanda provided the Board with information regarding the call for nominations on the Hugh Hammond Bennett award. No suggestions for nominations were provided.

Wyoming Weed and Pest Council Annual Meeting: Amanda provided information to the Board for the November 1-3, 2021 Annual Meeting.
